 - Active participation of all employees of State government, State PSUs, self-help groups, civil society organizations etc. and their families under your administrative jurisdiction.
 - ii. Corporate and private organizations may also be encouraged to participate and contribute including CSR resources.
 - Creating buzz/awareness building by utilizing websites & social media handles of State government. All State government websites to carry banners linking to Amrit Mahotsav Website – Har Ghar Tiranga corner (amritmahotsav.nic.lin).
 - iv. Outreach sessions with heads of panchayats at the level of concerned departments.
 - v. Identification of flag distribution and sales point in each village.

 - xii. Toll and check points to be branded, utilized for partiphlets & leaflets.
