

The college is permanently affiliated to the University of Gauhati during 2003-04 sessions and govt. concurrence was accorded to the college in 2005 w.e.f. the session 1997-98. In its quest for glory, college has become indebted to various institutions and individual. The college acknowledges gratefulness to all who directly and indirectly extended their helping hands, bore enormous pain and bestowed upon the society this esteemed institution.



The college is proud to have a main building with a big playground extending of a new Academic and Administrative block under the scheme of Govt. of Assam. At a little distance towards south, a sports complex and a women's hostel are constructed. The college is privileged in having a dynamic faculty committed to imparting quality education. There are 9 (nine) Departments in Arts stream in the college. Following the directives of Gauhati University the college had introduced semester system from the year 2011, CBCS system from the year 2019 and **FYUGP** from the year 2023, based on NEP 2020 in its undergraduate course. It is a matter of pride that within a very short span of time Vida Bharati College blossoms to fragrance and has established itself as a premier institution of higher education in the state.



VISION:

Vidya Bharati College envisions establishing itself as a premier institution of higher education. The college aims to provide quality education and make each of the students a jewel in the society capable of eliminating darkness through the light of the knowledge, self confidence and internal power.

MISSION:

Vidya Bharati College considers it as a mission to prepare the students to face the challenges of life courageously helping in the nation building operation.

GU-FYUGP:

The Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under Gauhati University is based on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The FYUGP is designed to cater to the diverse academic needs of the student and seeks to offer options of multiple entries / exits and obtain a Certificate or a Diploma or Degree with or without Major or a Degree (Honours) or a Degree (Honours) with Research at various levels as stipulated under the policy. The complete FYUGP consists of 8 semesters, to be completed in a minimum of 4academic years. Each academic year has two semesters. Each semester has a maximum credit allocation of 22. The fourth year of the GU-FYUGP consists of one compulsory course on Research Methodology of credit 4, to be studies in Semester VII. The rest of the course consist of Advance Core Courses and a Dissertation. All students, irrespective of their choice of subjects or degrees can advance to the fourth year either for a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) or a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) with Research.

Admission Eligibility:

(a) A student who has passed 12th standard or equivalent examination in any stream from a recognized institution.

(b) Admission to the FYUGP will be based on the preference of Major, if any. In case a student does not want to opt for any Major, she/he will be admitted on the basis of preferences of the subject combinations.

(c) Admission to a Programme or Major will be subject to availability of the subject and capacity of a college / department.

(d) No student shall be eligible for admission to a Programme in any discipline under the FYUGP unless she/he fulfills the pre-requisites of courses as fixed by the university.

Admission procedure:

For undergraduate courses, students will have to apply through **SAMARTH** and will have to apply in the **Vidya Bharati College Online Admission Portal** separately. The online admission portal available in the college website <u>www.vidyabharaticollege.org.in</u> is now live. The admission will be done as per the merit list, uploaded in the SAMARTH portal and college website. A student has to produce the following documents at the time of the admission-a) HSLC/HS Admit card b) Original mark sheet of last examination passed c) Original certificates from the head of the Institution last attended d) Gap certificate if needed d) Passport photograph 4 copies e) Caste certificate f) Migration transfer certificate g)

Certificate of proficiency in co curricular activities (extra ordinary) if any h) **Necessary documents applicable for free Admission**. i) Selection of students who want to pursue Major in any subject will be done in order of merit at the time of admission. j) Admission to the college hostel will be held immediately after the college admission for which separate application forms is to be submitted.

General Information for the Student:

- 1. Admission will be conducted as per NEP 2020 guidelines for FYUGP under Gauhati University.
- 2. Candidates have to apply through SAMARTH portal for admission.
- 3. In addition to Samarth portal candidates seeking admission in Vidya Bharati College must registrar in the college admission portal and have to submit the printed form with three passport photos and other documents along with the AADHAR card.
- 4. Merit list will be prepared and uploaded in the college website and SAMARTH portal.
- 5. Candidates must have to produce all the documents at the time of admission. The dates of admission process are notified in the college website based on the notification of Government of Assam.

Major Subject: Students pursuing undergraduate course may opt for core major in any one of the following subjects-

Assamese, English, Economics,

Education, History, Philosophy, Political Science

Minor Subject: Students have to select any two minor subjects from the following list


Anthropology, Assamese, English, Economics, Education,

History, Home Science, Philosophy, Political Science,

- Seat will be available in each minor subjects is 100. The seat will be provided on first cum first basis subject to the merit list.
- Students offering major and students not offering major course will have to choose any two minor subjects as mentioned above.

Compulsory subjects:

- a) Modern Indian language (MIL) Assamese or Alternative English for semester 1 and 5
- b) English communication for Semester 2 and 6
- c) Multi Disciplinary Course (MDC) in Natural Science/ Basic Mathematics/ Media and Information/ Basic Commerce in Semester 1, 2 and 3
- d) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) in Semester 1, 2 and 3
- e) Value Added Course (VAC) in semester 1, 2 and 4



4.1.1 Course-wise credit requirements

Below, we provide the minimum credit requirement for various course along with a mention of their semesters (as prescribed by the UGC).

(a) Core Course

a) First Major: 60 (Semesters 1-6)

b) Minor: 12 (Semesters 1-6)

c) Second Major (Double Major): 48 (Semesters 1-6)

(b) Common Course

a) Multidisciplinary: 9 (Semesters 1-3)

b) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC): 9 (Semesters 1-3)

c) Valued Added Course (VAC): 6 (Semesters 1, 2, 4)

d) Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): 8 (Semesters 1-2, 5-6)

- e) Internship: 4 (in any Semester from 3-6)
- f) Research Methodology: 4 (in any Semester in 5 or 7)

(c) For Honours and Honours with Research

a) Advanced Core, Dissertation: 40 (Semesters 7, 8)




Figure 3.1: Core Courses options — Option for a Major and two Minors.

3.1.1 Legends

VAC – Value Added Course SEC – Skill Enhancement Course Multi – Multidisciplinary Course AEC – Ability Enhancement Course INT – Internship REM – Research Methodology

Core courses:

The core courses constitute Majors and Minors. Usually, a student will choose one Major subject and two Minor subjects. All core courses have a credit allocation of 4. All together, irrespective of any Major or Minor options, a student will necessarily need to study 21 courses with total credit allocation of 84 over a 3-year programme.

Major Course:

The minimum credit requirements for a Major Course over a 3-year period are 60 which translate to 15 courses (papers)

Minor Course:

The minimum credit requirement for a Minor Course over a 3-year period is 12 which translates to 3 courses (papers).

Second Major Course:

If a student has a Major Course with 60 credits, she/he can convert one of her/his Minor Courses to a Second Major only with a credit allocation of 48. In that case, she/he gets a degree with Double Major and Minor. So, in general the total credit requirements of 84 in core courses translates to a single Major and two Minors. But a student can choose otherwise as well.

ABC (Academic Bank of Credits):

The GU-FYUGP is directly connected to the ABC (Academic Bank of Credit) as notified by the UGC. All credits a student earn at the end of an examination in GU-FYUGP, will be deposited in the ABC by the university.

FEE STRUCTURE:

Admission Fees details will be displayed on college notice board and college website as per notification of the Government of Assam
