The college is permanently affiliated to the University of Gauhati during 2003-04 sessions and govt. concurrence was accorded to the college in 2005 w.e.f. the session 1997-98. There are 9 (nine) Departments in Arts stream in the college. Following the directives of Gauhati University the college had introduced semester system from the year 2011, CBCS system from the year 2019 and FYUGP from the year 2023 (August Session), based on NEP2020 in its undergraduate course. It is a matter of pride that within a very short span of time Vidya Bharati College blossoms to fragrance and has established itself as a premier institution of higher education in the state.



## GU-FYUGP:

The Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under Gauhati University is based on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The FYUGP is designed to cater to the diverse academic needs of the student and seeks to offer options of multiple entries / exits and obtain a Certificate or a Diploma or Degree with or without Major or a Degree (Honours) or a Degree (Honours) with Research at various levels as stipulated under the policy. The complete FYUGP consists of 8 semesters, to be completed in a minimum of 4 academic years. Each academic year has two semesters. Each semester has a maximum credit allocation of 22. The fourth year of the GU-FYUGP consists of one compulsory course on Research Methodology of credit 4, to be studied in Semester VII. The rest of the course consists of Advance Core Courses and a Dissertation. All students, irrespective of their choice of subjects or degrees can advance to the fourth year either for a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) or a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) with Research.

### Admission Eligibility:

- A student who has passed 12th standard or equivalent examination in any stream from a recognized institution.
- Admission to the FYUGP will be based on the preference of Major, if any. In case a student does not want to opt for any Major, she/he will be admitted on the basis of preferences of the subject combinations in minor courses.
- Admission to a Programme or Major will be subject to availability of the subject and seat capacity of the College/Department.
- No student shall be eligible for admission to a Programme in any discipline under the FYUGP unless she/he fulfills the pre-requisites of courses as fixed by the university.

### Admission procedure:

For undergraduate courses, students will have to apply through SAMARTH only. Before applying, a candidate must have to read all information and visit the college website [www.vidyabharaticollege.org.in](http://www.vidyabharaticollege.org.in) thoroughly. The admission will be done as per the merit list, uploaded in the SAMARTH portal and college website. A student has to produce the following documents at the time of the admission-

### Evaluation guidelines under NEP:

**1. Internal evaluation:** Performance of students shall be monitored throughout the Semester by adopting Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation. It will have the following components, both in theory and practical

a. Internal, continuous evaluation (Formative Assessment): 40% of total marks in a paper

➤ 50% of the total marks in this category will be allocated for sessional/midterm test to be conducted as per GU guidelines (Example: If internal assessment marks of a subject is 40 then marks allotted for sessional examination will be 20)

➤ 50% will be allocated for internal assessment comprising any three of the following: a) Class assignment/home assignment/case studies b) Class test/Unit test c) Field work d) Group discussion e) Seminar presentation f) Participation in class discussion g) Quiz h) Any other evaluative method as determined by the concerned teacher

**2. External Evaluation:** End Semester Examination: 60% of total marks in a paper. Examinations, whether internal or external, theory or practical, would be counted separately for the purpose of considering a student as passed or failed.
